Ramadan Karting Challenge

The Ramadan Karting Challenge is series of three races during the month. The winner of the challenge is determined by the total number of points collected though the three races.

Round 1 : 12 September
Round 2 : 19 September
Round 3 : 26 September

Applications for participation in any event must be submitted no later than Monday 10pm before each race weekend accompanied with paid fees 45 JDs.

Late entry applications will be accepted till Friday 5pm with late entry fees 65 JDs.

Registration for three races together in advance will be 115 JDs.

Organizers will provide the drivers with practice and race photos for the following chargers:

Payment upon registration : 15 JDs (each race)
Anytime later : 25 JDs (each race)
(One CD for each diver with his photos only)

Entry fees are not refundable unless the entry was refused or the race was cancelled.

Participants will be driving at their own risk. Organizers and workers in the race are not responsible for any accidents to the drivers' and their karts.

Eligible Drivers:

All drivers should have a valid competition license from their ASN. Drivers from outside of Jordan should have a racing visa from their ASN. Entrants / Drivers should fill and sign the entry form. Drivers under the age 18 should have their form signed by their parents.

Technical Regulations:

Juniors Class:

Age : up to 12 years old
Engines : up to 8 hp
Chassis : Junior Chassis with wheel base 1010mm MAX
Weight : No weight limit

MAX Class

Age : Minimum age is 13
Engines : engines up to 125cc with no gear box
Chassis : ICA / KF homologated chassis – No front brakes are allowed
Weight : Weight of kart and driver, excluding fuel, should be 140kg minimum

Pro Class

Age : Minimum age is 15
Engines : ICA homologated engines
Chassis : ICA / KF homologated chassis
Weight : Weight of kart and driver, excluding fuel, should be 140kg minimum

Pro Juniors

Age : 13 and 14 years old
Engines : ICA homologated engines
Chassis : ICA / KF homologated chassis
Weight : Weight of kart and driver, excluding fuel, should be 135kg minimum

All karts must place 2 racing numbers, on the nose of the kart and on the rear bumper. Numbers must be printed in black on a yellow background. Please contact series organizers to confirm your racing number.

Karts participating in MAX and Pro Classes must have rear plastic protection.

Tire choice is open.

Tires will be marked at the scrutineering. Drivers are allowed to use 3 front tires and 3 rear tires of the same make and same model for the race.

Drivers should be wearing full racing gear (CIK approved) during the free practice, timed session, qualifying and the race.

Organizers Advertisement:

2 x (7 x 15 cm) organizer stickers to be placed on the sides of the kart

2 x (7 x 7 cm) organizer stickers to be placed on the front of the kart

Refusal to place the sponsor's stickers stated above is obliged to pay double entry fees.

Running of the Race:

All drivers must follow the race schedule and:

- It is mandatory to attend the drivers' briefing.
- Drivers who do not attend the briefing will be penalized up to exclusion of the race.
- Starting position will be determined by the best lap of each driver in the qualifying session. The fastest driver will be the first on the grid and so on.
- Juniors Race (10 laps)
- Max, Pro and Pro Jr. Pre-final: (15 Laps) Final: (25 Laps)
- Starting grid of the final heat depends on the results of the Pre-final heat.
- All races will be held at the Jordan Speed Center circuit.
 - Juniors' races : closed circuit
 - MAX, Pro and Pro Jr. : open circuit

MAX, PRO Juniors and PRO will be racing together.

Official Practice:

During official practice, all karts should have the transponder and should comply with the championship regulation.

Every Wednesday there will be two practice sessions:

Session 1	9:30pm	>	10:00pm
Session 2	10:30pm	>	11:00pm

No one is allowed on the track unless they are JSC members, temporary JSC members or have paid the practice fees of the day.

Practice Fees are JD 15.00 for each session. No One will be allowed on the track without a printed coupon delivered to the marshal.

Temporary membership will be given for the duration of one month. Fees are JDs 130 including storage box as well. Last day to register is September 10th.

Aside from Wednesday, practice is also available when the track is not occupied and no rental karts are running. It is free for those who have temporarily membership while who wish to practice day by day has to pay before practicing as stated above.

Non members drivers are not allowed to keep their karts at Jordan Speed Center after practice sessions and after the races.

Qualifying Session:

Drivers of each class will run qualifying session to determine the grid of the race. Drivers who leave the qualifying session are not allowed to rejoin unless they were asked to leave by the race organizers. Drivers who do not run in the qualifying session will start the race from the back of the grid.

Prizes:

Winners of each race will be awarded as the following:

Juniors' race:

1 st place	:	Gold Trophy
2 nd place	:	Silver Trophy
3 rd place	:	Bronze Trophy

Pro and MAX Race:

1 st place	:	Gold Trophy
2 nd place	:	Silver Trophy
3 rd Place	:	Bronze Trophy

Class winner:

Trophy for first place in the PRO Juniors group

Top five drivers from the seniors' class will get gift vouchers. Details will be posted later on the official notice board.

Points:

Finishers of the final race only will earn points as following:

Position	1st	2nd	3 rd	4th	5 th	6th	7 th	8th	9th	10th	11th	12th

Penalties

Any driver who does not comply with all safety regulations, track rules, championship regulations and any regulations or instructions of the officials of the race, shall inflict upon himself warnings and penalties that can lead to fines and can be up to exclusion from races and or the series.

Offenders will be issued warnings as follows:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning with penalty

Penalties include but are not limited to:

- Starting a race at the back of the grid
- Deduction or cancellation of race or championship points
- Disqualification from races
- Suspension from the series
- Fines

The above mentioned guidelines will generally be followed and are subject to the Clerk of the Course & Stewards' discretion.

Protests

Protests shall be submitted to the (CRO) not later than 20 minutes after the announcing of the heat results and must be accompanied by a fee of JD50. The protest fee is not refundable.

The Stewards' decisions regarding protests are final.
